ADMISSION TO TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM

1. Passing scores on the PRAXIS I test (175 Math, 176 Reading, 172 Writing). **Recommended:** Take the test during your Freshman year or as soon as you decide to become an Education major.
2. 2.5 GPA overall.
3. 21 credits and a 2.5 GPA in the content field (exception: Math 2.0 GPA) with at least 15 credits completed and 6 credits in progress. Grade of C or higher is required in each content field course.
4. Completion of or enrollment in prerequisites.

5. 10 of 30 required expectations completed and documented.
