LICENSE ADDITION: ENGLISH AS A NEW LANGUAGE

The State of Indiana has authorized Indiana University School of Education to offer License Additions in selected areas. A 3.0 GPA in ENL coursework is required. This program is only available to teacher candidates who are in the process of completing an initial license in a recognized Teacher Education Program.

In most cases it may not be possible to complete this license addition as part of the four year undergraduate degree program. A graduate option is available. Students should check with the Language Education Department to see when these courses are generally offered.
