LICENSE ADDITION: JOURNALISM

The State of Indiana has authorized Indiana University School of Education to offer License Additions in selected areas. The Journalism License Addition can be added to a Secondary License. This program is only available to teacher candidates who are in the process of completing an initial license in a recognized Teacher Education Program. A "C" or higher grade in each professional education course and a minimum 2.5 GPA in the license addition is required.
