TEST FEE WAIVER or FEE REIMBURSEMENT
For pre-EDUCATION STUDENTS

➤ **21st Century Scholars Program**

21st Century Scholars who pass a practice Praxis I exam administered by the IUB 21st Century Scholars Office may be eligible for a fee waiver granted through the School of Education. Contact the IUB 21st Century Scholars Office at 812-856-1910 or IUB21CS@indiana.edu for more information.

➤ **Hudson & Holland Scholars Program**

Contact the HHSP office at 812-855-7853 for approval of fee reimbursement **prior to taking the Praxis I** and for HHSP guidelines/timelines regarding when to take the test.

➤ **GROUPS Program**

If you do NOT qualify for Hudson & Holland Scholars funds or an ETS test fee waiver, contact Ghangis Carter regarding the School of Education (SoE) reimbursement of test fees (see details below). If you don't qualify for the SoE fund, Mr. Carter will redirect you to the GROUPS program for possible assistance.

➤ **SCHOOL of EDUCATION Reimbursement**

For underrepresented students who have completed no more than three semesters of undergraduate coursework at IUB: Contact Ghangis Carter, School of Education Director of Recruitment and Retention, Room 4105, or e-mail ghcarter@indiana.edu. **Note:** Your request for a fee reimbursement will be considered after you have already paid for and taken the Praxis I test. Passing scores are not required to qualify for reimbursement.

➤ **ETS Fee Waivers**

A limited number of fee waivers are available for enrolled undergraduate or graduate students who meet eligibility requirements. You must be receiving financial aid to qualify. Download the form before you go to the Office of Student Financial Assistance. Note the listed deadlines to apply for the fee waiver.
