The Department of Curriculum and Instruction in the School of Education at Indiana University, the flagship campus of the Indiana University system and a major comprehensive research university, invites applications for a faculty position in **Early Childhood Special Education**, to begin in August of 2012. The position is at the Assistant Professor Rank.

Responsibilities: Teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Early Childhood Education and Special Education, and supervise preservice teachers in their field experiences. Write grants and conduct inquiry that will lead to publications and other forms of knowledge distribution. Participate in the conceptualization and development of a unified program in Early Childhood Special Education.

Qualifications: An earned doctorate by the beginning date of appointment in early childhood education with special education experience or special education with experience in early childhood education. Applicants should have successful teaching experiences in inclusive Pre K-3 settings. In addition, successful university teaching experience in teacher education, publication potential in early childhood and/or special education, grant-getting potential or current grant-funded activity, and a willingness to actively engage and participate in professional organizations is desired. Ability to teach courses in equity, diversity and/or multicultural education also is desirable.

Application: Applicants should send: 1) a letter of application addressing qualifications and describing experiences and interests in teaching and research in to early childhood special education; 2) a current resume; and 3) contact information for three references.
