The FASE Mentoring Program was successful in hosting the second annual Men and Women of Color Leadership Conference held at Indiana University-Bloomington. The conference event occurred on the weekend of Nov. 12-13, 2010 in the Kelley School of Business and the Indiana Memorial Union. This conference provides a

platform from which students can assemble to discuss solutions to issues that impact communities of color. Specifically, the conference promotes academic excellence, building coalitions, career awareness, diversity education, empowerment, and leadership development.

This year's conference theme was "Pluralism, Antagonism, and Civil Engagement: Developing Leaders in 21st Century America." The planning committee invited some outstanding speakers who complemented the conference theme very well this year.

Conference speakers included Brown University Professor Dr. Evelyn Hu-Dehart and the mayor of Philadelphia, Mississippi Mayor James A. Young. Conference speakers also included Army Brigadier General Bryan T. Roberts and Maurer School of Law alumni Raphael A. Sanchez of Indianapolis.

This year's event attracted over 300 participants from 19 colleges and universities from across the Midwest and Southeast United States. Some students traveled from institutions such as Michigan State, Southeast Missouri State, Virginia Tech, and Wilberforce Universities. Conference attendees discussed issues relative to leadership, politics, and race. In addition PricewaterhouseCoopers sponsored a career event that allowed students to network with potential employers.
