

<b>FRENCH</b> <b>36 credits/2.5 GPA</b>
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1. All foreign language teaching majors require the completion of a minimum of 36 credit hours, including 30 hours in 300 and 400 level courses.

2. No course below the 200 level will count toward completion of the major.

3. All students must arrange for and complete the departmental language proficiency exam prior to completing EDUC BLOCK II Methods of Teaching Foreign Language. The examination may be taken more than once, but it must be passed before the student can be admitted to student teaching. See your methods of foreign language instructor for additional information.

4. Not all classes are scheduled to be taught each semester. Check COAS bulletin or language department to confirm when the course is expected to be offered.

**200-Level Work (6 credit hours)**

Choose one of the following options:

1. Complete:
