### How to set a Front Page in a course?

- The page must be published before setting the front page.
- Click the **Pages** in the side navigation bar.
- Click the **View All Pages**.
- Click the Options icon and then click the **Use as Front Page**.
- The Front Page will be marked by a gray Front Page tag.
