Policy on Grades

No grade below C may count as credit for graduate degrees offered by the School of Education.

Revalidation of Outdated Coursework

This replaces the last paragraph of the 4/28/82 policy (PC-82.43M)

The Advisory Committee is responsible for filing a plan, with justification, for revalidating outdated course work on a course by course basis. The plan will be made part of the student's program planning sheets and official records in the Office of Graduate Studies. At the time of admission to candidacy, supporting documents from each Indiana University department offering courses being updated will be filed with the Director of Graduate Studies as evidence of currency in course work.
