

Proposed change in Ed.S. School Psychology Admissions

The School Psychology faculty would like to propose the following change in admissions for the Ed.S in School Psychology

The GRE will NOT be required for students who have a minimum undergraduate or graduate GPA of 3.0 from an accredited U.S. institution. All other student will be required to submit GRE Scores.

Other admissions criteria will not change.

Justification:

The school psychology program faculty have voted to change GRE requirements for the EdS in school psychology program. The aim of this change is to implement an admissions process that is more inclusive and increases the applicant pool. For example, we want students to apply who might be working full-time and wanting to return to school for a school psychology, but who may have been away from school and are reluctant to take the GRE.
