

## **Update to Admission Process for Graduate Studies Committee 2.8.2022**

### **Admission Process**

Starting in February 2022 the Graduate Studies Office will take over admission of the School of Education collaborative programs from IU Online.

IU Online ran admissions in 2021 for our two active programs. This presented issues with communication and updates on the applicant and admission status.

These programs will now be managed by the Graduate Studies Office as other School of Education programs are.

Because these programs are collaborative, applicants that meet the admission criteria will be directly admitted by our Online Admission Coordinator, Iesha Sturgis-Jackson. In cases when a student does not meet the criteria Iesha will work with the program faculty on a decision.

This change will allow:

- Clearer communication with applicant/admittee and program.
- Easier application assistance.
- Ability to communicate with applicants who haven't finalized submission.
- Rebranding of application from IU Online to School of Education.
- Direct admission will save faculty time.
