Program Changes Made
in order to meet
120 Credit-Hour Requirement**

In order to meet the 120 credit-hour limit legislation, changes were made to two programs: Elementary Education and Secondary Social Studies.

For Elementary Education, we reduced the Area of Concentration requirements. They now align with the areas included in the content requirements, so when combined they range from 12 credits (Fine Arts) to 18 credits (Science). In addition, we also reduced the M420 seminar from two credits to one credit (which now matches M420 in Secondary Education). The attached Elementary Education credit summary demonstrates how various distribution requirements can be met in 120 credits.

For Secondary Social Studies, we adjusted the Political Science Concentration—Y105 is now a requirement, and then students must choose between either Y107 or Y109 (these will then double-count with S&H requirements). The lower portion of the attached Social Studies credit summary chart demonstrates how a four-year plan results in a social studies license in 120 credits.

With the exception of the dual-license Teaching All Learners program, all other licensure programs can already be completed in 120 hours without any changes in program requirements.
