

IUB Secondary Social Studies requirements

Proposed policy: Secondary Social Studies candidates who choose History as their primary subject area (30 credits) will be required to take:

- 1 course in pre-1750 history
- 1 course in post-1750 US or European history
- 1 course in post-1750 non-US/European or world history
- H270 What is History?
- J400 Seminar in History
- J425 Capstone Seminar in History
- 18 of the 30 credits must be at the 300 and/or 400 level

To be considered by IUB Committee on Teacher Education on March 21, 2016

Background: Indiana legislation requires that secondary teacher candidates fulfill requirements equivalent to a minor in their subject area. At IUB, secondary Social Studies candidates have the option of fulfilling requirements in either History or Political Science. The History Department has changed their major requirements, effective in Summer 2016, and this policy will make requirements for our candidates consistent with those changes.
