

In 2017 the Theatre Department announced their intention to discontinue offering Theatre Education courses that support the license and license addition in Theatre Education. In order to continue providing Theatre Education at IUB, the School of Education will offer a license addition in Theatre Education for students in Secondary Education. The program involves 4 courses (Z204, Z305, Z402, and M484), an early field experience (M403), and a 6-week student teaching practicum (M470). This program would be available for students matriculating in Fall 2018 or later.
