## II. Action Items - Course and Program Changes:

1. Proposed Early Childhood Education Program Changes: Handouts - Spring Jr Course Change and Increase in Prog Hours

E354 Block Structure Change

Cary Buzzeli, on behalf of Early Childhood Education (ECE) faculty, is requesting that the E354 course, a 12 credit hour block course, revert back to its original design as four separate courses taken in a block format. The rationale given was that instructors of this course would like more autonomy between classes. He also stated that remediation is difficult for students in its current format. Cary Buzzeli stated that he would talk with Margrethe O'Connor to work out the logistics of making sure these four courses stayed as a block for ECE students. Tim Niggle motioned to accept this portion of the proposal and it was seconded by Ben Edmonds: MOTION APPROVED UNANIMOUSLY.

Increase in Program Hours in Early Childhood Education Program

Cary Buzzeli, on behalf of the ECE faculty, would like to increase the credit hours for E450.

According to Cary Buzzeli the work load for the instructor has increased over time and they would like to reflect that change in a credit increase. The committee expressed hesitation because the rationale did not include information about the work load on the students and if it had changed as well.
