Activities for the year

- 1) The Bloomington Student Grievance Hearing Committee (Grievance Committee) held a fall orientation meeting to introduce new members to the purpose and general procedures of the committee.
- 2) The committee convened hearings and made recommendations to Executive Associate Dean Peter Kloosterman in response to two grievances filed by students. The first hearing was actually held in May, 2004, after the committee report had already been turned in, and the second was held this spring. The grievances concerned the non-award of student teaching credit and denial of admission to a graduate program, respectively.

The committee wishes to thank Barbara Bichelmeyer for volunteering to make up the required number of faculty for the second hearing this year when schedule conflicts and prior involvement with the case under appeal prevented some other regular members of the committee from serving.
