Counseling Program Course Sequencing

This document provides you with sample sequencing for the master's programs in counseling. You will work with your advisor to do a plan of studies that meets the requirements of your specific program. <u>Any changes to the sequencing below should be</u> done in consultation with your advisor.

Guiding notes:

- Please consult with your advisor during your first semester to plan your courses.
- Students often find it helpful to do a table by semester with courses they plan to take
- Electives should be at least a 500-level course and need to be approved by your advisor.
- Please note that most full-time students take 12 credits in the fall and spring terms and 6-9 in the summer.
- In the sample sequencing below, you will see where there is flexibility to make some choices. This helps if a class ends up filling and you have to move it to another term. For example, Y520 is offered every semester. So, if you don't get in in the summer, you can take it in the fall or spring.
- You are required to take 6 credits of G647 over the course of the program (3 credits in each of two semesters). Please make sure that when you enroll in G647 that you sign up for 3 credits each term. Consult with your advisor if you have questions about this.
