LICENSE ADDITION: ENGLISH AS A NEW LANGUAGE (ENL)

The ENL License Addition can be added to an Elementary, Secondary or All-Grades license. This program is only available to students pursuing their first education degree. A grade of "C" or higher in each course and a 2.5 GPA in the license addition is required.

NOTE:

- It may not be possible to complete this license addition as part of the four-year undergraduate degree program. A graduate option is available.
- A basic working knowledge of a world language is necessary for this license addition.
- An unlimited number of education courses may double count for both an education program and a license addition.
- An unlimited number of education courses may double count for multiple license additions.
- Only one (1) course may double count for both a license addition and an academic minor.

ENL LICENSE ADDITION REQUIREMENTS 16 credits/2.5 GPA

A grade of C or higher is required in each course.
