HIGHER EDUCATION AND STUDENT AFFAIRS CERTIFICATE

The Higher Education and Student Affairs Certificate is designed for students who are interested in exploring the role of student affairs in higher education. The program has an emphasis on the essential knowledge, intellectual competencies and practical skills necessary to work within a higher education setting.

- NOTE:**
- Students must complete 15 credits for the certificate. All courses must be completed with a grade of C or higher. Courses must average a minimum of 2.50 overall to earn the minor.
 - Only one (1) course may double count for both a license addition and an academic minor.
 - Only one (1) education course may overlap between an education program and an academic minor.
 - No course overlap is allowed between academic minors and/or certificates. (i.e., EDUC-U 330 cannot be used to fulfill a requirement in both the Higher Education and Student Affairs Certificate and the International and Comparative Education minor.)
 - Courses from other academic units on campus cannot be used to fulfill a requirement for both an education program and an academic minor (i.e., HIST-H 105 cannot be used to fulfill a social studies education program and academic minor in History requirement.)
 - Exception: Elementary Education Content (Language Arts, Fine Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies) and one of the designated academic minors may double count classes.
