LICENSE ADDITION: READING

The State of Indiana has authorized Indiana University School of Education to offer License Additions in selected areas. The Reading License Addition can be added to an Elementary, Secondary or All-Grades License. This program is only available to students pursuing their first education degree. A grade of "C" or higher in each education course and a minimum 2.5 GPA in the license addition is required. All coursework must be completed prior to student teaching.

It may not be possible to complete this license addition as part of the four year undergraduate degree program. A graduate option is available.
