LICENSE ADDITION: THEATRE



The State of Indiana has authorized Indiana University School of Education to offer License Additions in selected areas. The Theatre License Addition can be added to a Secondary License. This program is only available to students pursuing their first education degree. This license addition requires the completion of 32 credits beyond the initial Teacher Education Program. A grade of "C" or higher in each theatre and education course, and a minimum 2.5 GPA in the license addition is required.

It may not be possible to complete this license addition as part of the four year undergraduate degree program. A graduate option is available.
