## LICENSE ADDITION: THEATRE

The Theatre License Addition can be added to a Secondary License. This program is only available to students pursuing their first education degree. This license addition requires the completion of 32 credits beyond the initial Teacher Education Program. A grade of "C" or higher in each course, and a minimum 2.5 GPA in the license addition is required.

### NOTE:

- It may not be possible to complete this license addition as part of a four year undergraduate degree program. A graduate option is available.
- Students should check with the Theatre, Drama & Contemporary Dance Department (812-855-4342) to see when these courses are offered.
- An unlimited number of education courses may double count for both an education program and a license addition.
- An unlimited number of education courses may double count for multiple license additions.
- Only one (1) course may double count for both a license addition and an academic minor.

### SECONDARY OPTION

32 credits/2.5 GPA

A grade of C or higher is required in each course.

Students are advised to take the courses in a building progression (i.e., T100 should be taken first in the progression of study.)
